Kathy's Class Information

Our preschool program will help your child begin to develop his/her emotional, physical, and intellectual skills, while teaching important social skills. We focus on developing large and small motor skills for mobility development and coordination. Our teachers provide nurturing supervision and positive guidance through consistency, encouragement and support. Teachers use an emergent curriculum which permits learning activities that arise from each child's interests, encouraging feelings of security and confidence in an age-appropriate atmosphere where each child feels free to explore, play, observe, question and make discoveries. Learning activities and children's experiences also align with the Pennsylvania Early Learning Standards. Children learn about Jewish customs, traditions, holidays, and they develop a connection to the Land of Israel and its people. Tzedakah and Mitzvot, charity and kindness are two major concepts that guide our Jewish learning. This class goes outside everyday (weather permitting), enjoys lots of stories and songs during circle time, participates in weekly music class, gym class, creative movement, J-Play and joins the rest of the school on Fridays for Shabbat.
