Toddler Class Information

The Toddler classroom environment encourages exploration. Teachers design experiences that are safe, nurturing and stimulating to help children explore and make discoveries. The staff uses open ended activities and materials that promote inquiry and investigation. The children in these classes are just beginning to communicate their needs on their own. The staff creates an environment rich in language and play using movement, blocks, music, books, nature, water, art and dramatic play materials to enhance children's growth and development. Children in the Toddler class enjoy music and story time, walks outside every day and outdoor play time in the private Toddler Playground (weather permitting) where they can safely use equipment and develop strong gross motor skills. They also participate in weekly music class and J-Play. This class will celebrate Shabbat with the rest of the school each week.
