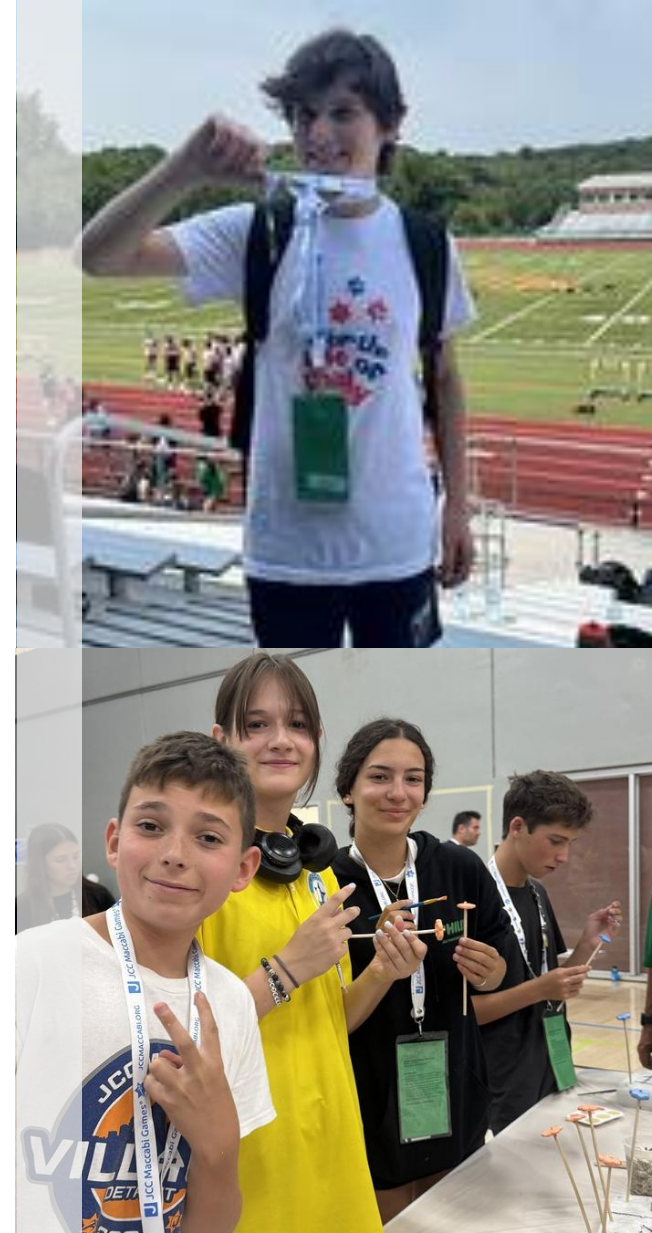

(Birthdates between August 8, 2008-August 2, 2013)

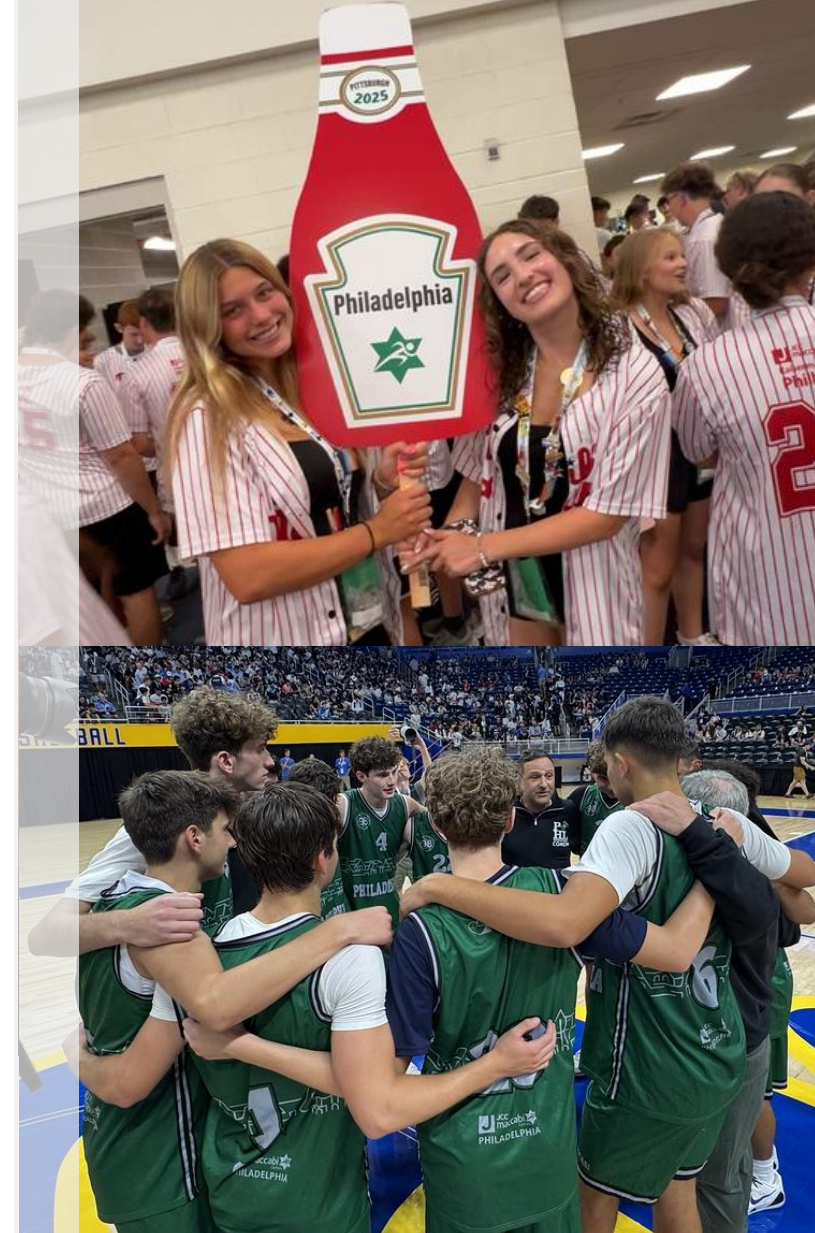
All athletes must be Jewish - defined as follows:

One of the athletes parents is Jewish and the athlete is being raised Jewish or is a Jew by choice and is being raised Jewish. In the spirit of JCC Maccabi if the parent or child does not believe that they are Jewish on a year around basis, then the child should not participate in JCC Maccabi programs. In the athlete registration, there is a declaration that contains the eligibility requirements; both the athlete and his/ her parent(s) must sign this declaration.

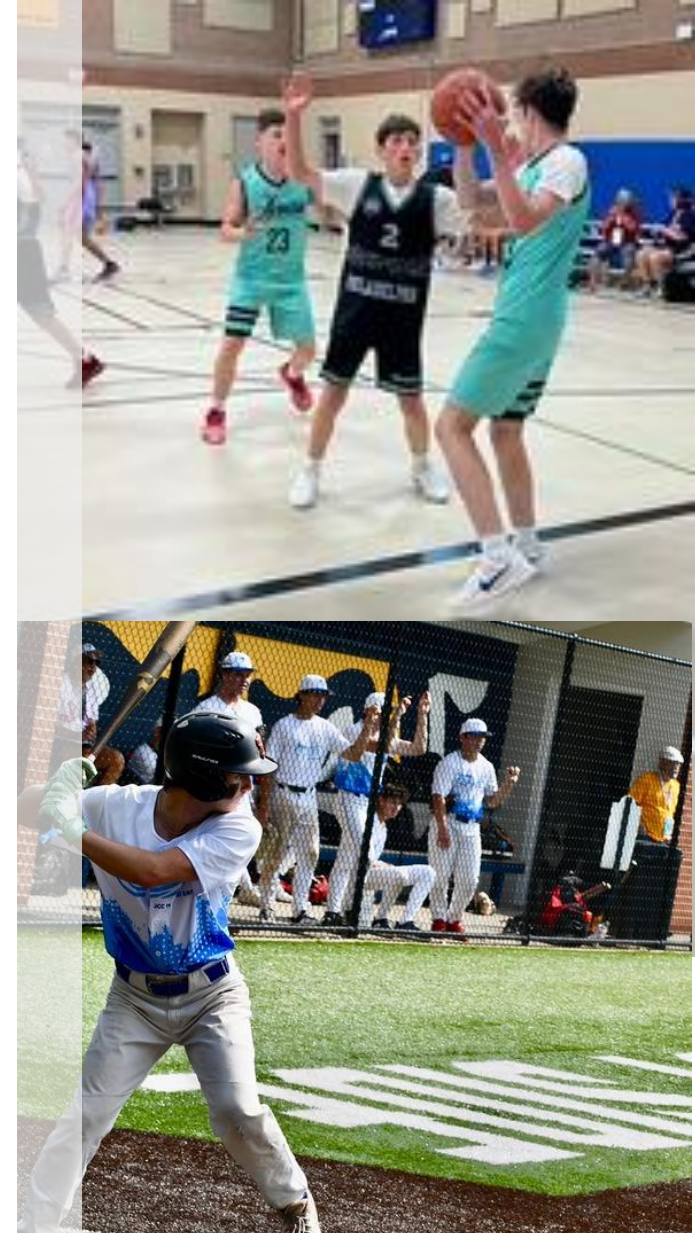

JCC MACCABI 2026 SAFETY

- Credentials
- Host community Partnership with law enforcement on levels:
 - Local
 - State
 - Federal
- A 1:8 ratio will be maintained at all times
- Coaches and Delegation heads are responsible for the supervision of all athletes
- All Spectators must complete background checks



JCC MACCABI 2026 SPECTATORS

- **Spectator Credentials**- Needed by everyone attending the games, must be purchased in advance
 - Must complete background check after purchase
 - All passes must be purchased by July 30th, 2026.
- **Maccabi System**- Athletes cannot be taken out of the system. During the week of the Games, the DH is responsible for their athletes. Parents may not take their children away from the JCC Maccabi venues.



JCC MACCABI 2026 REGISTRATION

- Cost: \$2500
- All inclusive: travel, uniform, adult supervision, meals, accommodation, national registration fees, transportation, and all activities
- Scholarships available on a specific need case by case basis locally and on a national level
